

## HOW TO RUN THE HIGH ACHIEVERS SCHOLARSHIP SAMPLE APTITUDE TEST

The Sample Aptitude Test (SAT) for the prospective students of High Achievers Scholarship Program has been uploaded on the ICAP website. The 'SAT' is available in the same examination software that will be used for the actual examination.

Please note that the main objective of providing 'SAT' in software is to make the student familiar with the environment and features of the examination software.


### Step-by-Step Process to Access SAT

Following is the step-by-step process to run the SAT:

#### Step 1: Visit the ICAP Website

- Go to the [ICAP Website](#).
- Hover over the **Students** tab in the top navigation bar.

#### Step 2: Access the Practice Test


- Scroll down the page and locate the heading **Model Paper for ICAP Aptitude Test**.
